

FLAPPING BUTTERFLY


This amazing paper butterfly flaps its wings just like a real butterfly. Esther showed this to me in Hong Kong.




1. Take a 15-cm square paper. Fold it along the diagonal and open.




2. Mark a point with pencil 2-cm from the corner on the diagonal.




3. Fold the other end to this point.




4. Mark another point 2cm away from the new corner.




5. Fold a small triangle on this corner as shown.




6. Draw two skewed triangles indicated by dotted lines.



7. Fold the dotted lines and ...



8.lift the small triangle like a nose.




9. Fold the model in half. The small triangle and skewed triangles should be exposed.




10. Draw the wings and antennae of the butterfly with a pencil.



11. Cut them with a scissors.





12. Now hold the front tip of the butterfly with your left hand and pull the arrow down with the right hand to make the butterfly flap its wings.
